The Platte County Health Department has expanded its H1N1 vaccination clinics for the following groups, as identified by the CDC:

- Pregnant women (you must present an order from your Obstetrician); and
- Persons over the age of 6 months;

Please note: H1N1 vaccine is **not** available for children under 6 months of age.

These clinics are for **Platte County Residents ONLY**. You will need to bring proof of residency with you such as a property tax receipt or a utility bill in your name.

The clinics will be held:

- H1N1 vaccinations will be offered at the **Parkville** location, 1201 East Street, **Monday through Friday**, 8:00 am – 6:00 pm. No appointment is necessary.
- H1N1 vaccinations will be offered at the **Platte City** location, 212 Marshall Road, on **Mondays and Wednesdays** from 8:00 am – 6:00 pm. No appointment is necessary.

Only Platte County residents are eligible for these clinics and the vaccine is free. You may fill out the consent form prior to visiting our clinic. Click on the following link to access the consent form:
